Sadly, this past August, Jeanne Vielbig, past President and Vice-President of the North Haven Trails Association, died just a few weeks shy of her 98th birthday. North Haven's Vielbig Loop Trail is named in her honor for her tireless efforts in creation of the trail system and conservation in general. In 2003, NHTA dedicated a teak park bench to Jeanne in recognition of her many years of service. Jeanne, for decades, was active in civic affairs in both Sag Harbor and North Haven.

Our resident pair of ospreys returned this past Spring. They have continued to enlarge their nest and have produced offspring for the third consecutive year. Take advantage of the serenity of the fall

and winter seasons to hike the trails. Take a break by relaxing on the bench dedicated to Jeanne and enjoying the panoramic view. The first frost will diminish the threat from ticks.

Perhaps you've noticed that you have not received the customary solicitation of dues and notice of regularly scheduled Trails Association activities. The reasons have to do with the problem of ticks and chiggers, and the limited participation in our scheduled events. As a result, we have refrained from sponsoring activities on the trails. With no formal activities and with the Village providing for much of the maintenance of the Jean Vielbig Loop Trail, our expenses have been minimal. Seeing no need to raise funds at this

time, NHTA decided not to do a Village-wide dues drive.
