Last day to place this notice in paper Feb 16, 2020
- Feb. 16 First day for the clerk to accept absentee ballot applications
- March 31 First Day to sign Independent Nomination Petition
- April 17 Board Resolution: Polling Place, time & hours of election
(last day) Authorize rental of voting machine, etc.
Appoint Inspectors of Election **send 3/27**
- April 13 Order Voting Machine, Custodian, voters list
- April 17 Notify Inspectors and administer oath (**appoint April BOT** must be by 5/7/20)
- May 5 First Day to file Independent Nominating Petition
- May 12 Last Day to File Independent Nominating Petitions
- May 13 Last day to file written objections to independent nominating petitions
- May 15 Last Day to file written specifications of objections to independent nominating petitions
- May 15 Last day for Clerk to notify those nominated and provide certificates of acceptance and/or declination.
- May 15 First filing of campaign receipts and expenditures

- May 20 Draw for position on ballot. 10:00 a.m.
